

GENERAL AND EXTRA SUBJECT FEES FOR 2025-2026

School Fees are set at an annual rate, running January – December, split into three equal termly payments and are payable on or before the first day of the term for which they are due. All fees are invoiced in advance with the exception of Incidental Expenses and Additional Specialist Support which are invoiced one term in arrears. Fees are payable by Direct Debit either termly on the first day of term or monthly which is collected in equal instalments on the first working day of the four months preceding the start of the term.

Day Fees (covering 8.00am to 5.30pm) Year 7-8 £9,642 per term (£8,820 from January 2026)

Day Fees (covering 8.00am to 5.30pm) Year 9-13 £9,852 per term (£9,996 from January 2026)

Day fees are inclusive of a morning snack, lunch and afternoon tea and the catering team also provides nutritious food for a range of dietary requirements. The majority of after school clubs and activities are free of charge and girls may remain at school until 5:30pm to do supervised prep.

Boarding Nights Offer for Day Students (to be used in the academic year subject to availability)

Year 7 to 8 Includes boarding vouchers: Platinum (free night Yr 7 only), Bronze (25% discount), Silver (50% discount), Gold (75% discount), to be used in that order.

Year 9 to 13 From Jan 2026 includes 10 free nights boarding for Yr 9-11 and 1 free night per week for Sixth Form per academic year

Boarding Nights Offer for Half Weekly and Weekly Boarders (to be used in the academic year subject to availability)

Year 9 to 11 - 10 free nights (from January 2026) as an extended third or sixth night

Sixth Form - one free night per week (from January 2026) as an extended third or sixth night

Full Boarding Fees Year 7-8 £15,642 per term (£16,268 from January 2026)

Full Boarding Fees Year 9-13 £16,098 per term (£16,742 from January 2026)

Weekly Boarding Fees Year 7-8 £14,448 per term (£15,026 from January 2026)

Weekly Boarding Fees Year 9-13 £14,964 per term (£15,563 from January 2026)

Fees for Full and Weekly Boarding include the same benefits provided for day pupils plus a cooked breakfast and supper. Laundry, evening activities, prep supervision and medical centre services are also provided. Boarding staff can arrange visits to the dentist, doctor and optician and will assist with travel arrangements, which will incur an extra charge.

Half-Weekly Boarding Fixed two-day per week, termly package (either Monday/Tuesday or Wednesday/Thursday), paid in advance. Please note the price excludes Day Fees.

Fees Year 7-8 £174 for two fixed consecutive nights (£180 from January 2026)

Fees Year 9-13 £186 for two fixed consecutive nights (£192 from January 2026)

Occasional Boarding on an ad-hoc basis £96 per night (£108 from January 2026)

Half-Weekly and Occasional Boarding fees exclude Day fees but do include a cooked breakfast, supper and snacks from the boarding pantries. Laundry, evening activities, prep supervision and medical centre services are also provided.

Trips and Visits: Trips and Visits are charged separately. The majority of these are relatively low cost but there are also higher cost, optional trips offered, for which advance notice will be given.

School Bus Service: Prior's Field participates in the Eco Schools Scheme and has been awarded two Green Flags, the highest level of award in the Scheme. As part of this Scheme, we strive to minimise the School's environmental impact and one of the ways the pupils can contribute is by using school transport. Boarders' Transport to London on Fridays: The School provides free, accompanied travel to London on the train. This is booked through the Boarding Team on an ad-hoc basis.

Public Examination Fees will be charged at the rate in force at the time.

Please note that fees and any agreed supplemental charges will not be reduced or refunded as a result of absence due to illness or otherwise. In the event that a pupil takes study leave at home before or during public examinations, or stays at home following those examinations, no reduction of fees will be made in respect of such periods spent at home.

Notice Periods

- One full term's notice, in writing to the Head, is required to withdraw a pupil.
- One full term's notice in writing to the Boarding Team is required for a change from Boarding to Day or within Boarding type (Half-Weekly, Weekly or Full).
- Any tuition, whether for Learning Development, EAL, extra tuition or extracurricular subjects (e.g. LAMDA, Tennis and Instrumental lessons), also requires one full term's notice in writing. The notice, in this case, should be sent to the Bursar, with the exception of music lessons, where notice should be provided to the teacher.
- A decision to stop using School Buses requires half a term's notice and should be given using the 'contact' us option in the bus page on the website <https://priorsfieldschool.vectare.co.uk/>

"One full term's notice" means notification that is received on or before the first day of the preceding term. Should the notice period not be adhered to, a term's fees in lieu of notice will be charged.

"Half a term's notice" means notification that is received on or before the first day of the preceding half term. Should the notice period not be adhered to, a half term's fees in lieu of notice will be charged.
